



## Educational Charters on "American Spirit"

Age Group: Middle/High School Time: 3hrs Boat Based

**Concept:** The sailing fundamentals and the corresponding nomenclature aboard the "American Spirit".

**Objective:** The Students will be educated on how to raise/lower the sails safely and will know the definition and location of the Main, Fore and Jib Sails. Students will also be introduced to the points of sail and the corresponding sail trim required to effectively sail the "Spirit".

<u>Introduction:</u> The introduction will include the location of the sail and the lines that are used to control them. Students will be encouraged to pull on the lines to see the effect on each part of the sail.
